#### The Court of Arbitration for Sport rules that:

- 1. The appeal filed on 30 March 2017 by Taekwondo Federation of Moldova against the decision of the National Olympic and Sports Committee of Moldova Executive Board on 9 March 2017 is dismissed.
- 2. The decision of the National Olympic and Sports Committee of Moldova Executive Board on 9 March 2017 is upheld.
- 3. The costs of the arbitration, to be determined and served to the parties by the CAS Court Office, shall be paid 80% by the Taekwondo Federation of Moldova and 20% by the National Olympic and Sports Committee of Moldova.
- 4. The Taekwondo Federation of Moldova is ordered to pay to the National Olympic and Sports Committee of Moldova the amount of CHF 5,000 (five thousand Swiss Francs) as a contribution to the legal fees and expenses incurred in relation to the present proceedings.
- 5. All other motions or prayers for relief are dismissed.
